02.06.2025, Day 1

10:30 Arrival to Tartu by minibus, short stretching and coffee break.

Drive to the northern shore of Lake Peipus which is a popular holiday destination unique for its natural beauty. Kauksi is one of the most beautiful and best-known beaches in the area. You can get to the beach of "singing sands", which is several kilometres long, via a stairway over the dunes.

12:30 Lunch by Catering Kene at Kauksi Beach Centre.

Site inspection of Peipsi Villad.

The lisaku Museum gives an overview of history, culture, and nature of the area.

<u>Alutaguse Sports Centre</u> is located in the picturesque Kurtna Lake District in the heart of Alutaguse National Park, offering ideal conditions for outdoor activities and relaxation all year round.

<u>Valaste Waterfall</u>, located on the <u>Ontika limestone cliff</u>, is more than 30 m high, making it the highest waterfall in Estonia.

Check in and site inspection of <u>Saka Manor</u>, pearl of the North-Estonian coastal cliffs.

Adventurous hike on the coast and fossil hunting.

Dinner at restaurant Cliff.

Evening spa, saunas, enjoying the sunset.



03.06.2025 Day 2

Breakfast at the hotel and check out.

<u>Kiviõli Adventure Centre</u>, offers a wide range of adrenaline-pumping activities and outdoor adventures for visitors of all ages.

Site inspection of Tuhamäe Hostel and Rosi Holiday House.

<u>Adventures at full speed</u> – offroad safary around Aidu quarry. Tha safary routes wind through the picturesque landscapes of Aidu Quarry and its surroundings, offering stunning









views of rock formations and lakes, providing a unique and memorable adventure experience.

<u>Estonian Mining Museum</u> tour under the ground and miners lunch. Step back in time and get an insight into the country's mining history, which has played a significant role in its economy and development over the centuries.

<u>Vaivara Museum</u> was opened in 2008, in an old renovated manor granary. The museum is located in the Sinimäe settlement in the city of Narva-Jõesuu, which primarily introduces objects related to the Battle of Sinimägi during World War II.

Drive to <u>Narva-Jõesuu</u>. Narva-Jõesuu is known as a resort town whose glory days are decades behind. Narva-Jõesuu is famous for its unique natural environment. Narva-Jõesuu beach with its fine sand, lined with a peculiar pine forest, is one of the longest sea beaches in Estonia, running for 9.5 km along the southern shore of the Gulf of Finland. Today, it has become a well-known summer resort for guests of the region.

Check in and site inspection of Meresuu Spa & Hotel

Buffet dinner at the hotel, free time for spa and saunas, sunset, beachwalk.



04.06.2025 Day 3

Breakfast at the hotel and check out.

<u>The motorboat Caroline</u> takes us on a scenic cruise along the Narva river from Narva-Jõesuu to Narva. We enjoy beautiful views of the Estonian-Russian border river along the way. The boat trip lasts 1 hour and 20 minutes.

Tour in Narva - Narva Promenade, Five-Kroon viewing platform, Kreenholm Industry legacy, Narva Town Hall, Casemates of Victoria Bastion and VR experiences.

Lunch at restaurant Pärl.

<u>Sillamäe</u>, a town located on the northeastern coast of Estonia, known for its unique history, culture heritage, and picturesque coastal landscapes.

Sillamäe Museum, sightseeings, history, promenade walk.
